There will be microscope sessions in which participants will view preserved and live specimens while receiving hands-on training in identification. No direct experience with algae required, but workshop targets participants with backgrounds in biology and scientific methods.

Participants are strongly encouraged to bring their own samples for analysis. There will be time to discuss any specific taxonomic and management issues that are encountered in your system.

All attendees will receive a manual that covers algal methods, identification, ecology, and control - prepared by the instructor and based on three decades of professional experience. 1-2 students per microscope.
